Appalachian Hardwood Manufacturers records indicate that it is time to renew your **Certified Appalachian Legal & Sustainable** participation. This third-party audited program certifies your company's sourcing as meeting the standards adopted by the AHMI Board of Trustees.

Logs, lumber and products from the 344-county Appalachian Region will be **Certified Appalachian Hardwood Sustainable** utilizing U.S. Forest Service Forest Inventory Analysis. The 2019 update proves a growth-to-removal ratio of 2.4 to 1, far exceeding sustainability. This program will certify your membership in AHMI, sourcing from the region and the FIA data analysis.

Logs, lumber and products will be Certified Appalachian Hardwood Legal and will show:

- Your company is a member of good standing in AHMI;
- Your company is a legal entity in the United States and adheres to the rule of law;
- Your products are legally sourced with proof from your suppliers.

AHMI has contracted with a third-party auditor to certify your company to these standards and you can choose to do either or both. Enclosed you will find:

- Standards for both programs and the audit procedure;
- Sample product certificate;
- List of Appalachian Hardwood Counties;
- Procurement Form for your vendor to complete and give you to keep on file if a question arises about the origin of logs, lumber or products.

- (1) the company is a member of good standing in AHMI;
- (2) the company sources more than 50% of timber and lumber products from the 344-county Appalachian Region as the AHMI bylaws define.
- (3) Sustainability is verified by USFS Forest Inventory Analysis as growth exceeding removal plus mortality in the 344-county Appalachian Hardwood region;

Certified Appalachian Hardwood Legal Participating Member Declaration

1. Responsibility

The Appalachian Hardwood Manufacturers, Inc. (AHMI) member company has appointed an employee who shall be responsible for implementing this Policy and discussing relevant issues regularly with the highest level of management. The company will make all employees associated with timber purchasing aware of the Policy and its commitments, and provide appropriate education and training to allow its full implementation. The company recognizes that it has a responsibility to the environment, customers, suppliers and staff to base its commercial activities on well-managed forests.

2. Legality

The AHMI member company adheres to all local, state and federal laws and condemns illegal logging practices. The company is committed to purchasing all timber from legal sources and will obtain all available evidence of compliance from suppliers that they are operating in accordance with the laws of their country.

3. Traceability and Supplier Monitoring

The AHMI member company will perform an assessment of each Supplier to obtain information regarding the sources of raw material used in the manufacture of hardwood products. This information will form part of purchasing decisions and will be made available to auditors in accordance with the Policy.

4. Continuous Improvement

The AHMI member company is committed to purchase timber and timber products from sustainably managed forests and will work with relevant groups to develop its purchasing policy.

5. Reporting and Audit

The AHMI member company will maintain records and report when required to AHMI in accordance with the Policy. A third-party will assess and certify the company's progress and compliance under the Policy.



Certified Appalachian Hardwood Legal Standards

Below are the requirements of the **Certified Appalachian Hardwood Legal** program for forest management, hardwood lumber producing and distributing companies. Please complete each standard for your company and return for a third-party audit to these standards.

The Certified Legal program requires participants:

- 1) Be a member of good-standing in AHMI
- 2) Operate a legal business entity.

3) Follow accepted industry practices and all local, state and federal laws applicable to forest management and timber harvesting including all applicable environmental regulations.
4) Pay all compensation, taxes and fees due to timber owners or the owner's designated representative and government entities as required by local, state and federal laws
5) Purchase the majority of logs, lumber and products from the AHMI territory.

Standard 1) Legal Business Entity

The company is a corporation, limited liability company or partnership, duly organized and existing under the laws of a State of the U.S.A. or Canada, or a sole proprietorship owned and operated by a citizen and resident of a State of the U.S.A. or Canada. The company and its contractors and supplier have valid contracts to purchase the timber, and all required permits and licenses to harvest timber on the Forest Management Unit (FMU) have been issued by the appropriate authority.

Standard 2) Forest Management and Timber Harvesting Agreements

2.a Forest Management and Timber harvest operations follow accepted industry practices and comply with local, state and federal law.
